Something Lacy Shrug

Need a light layer over a summer dress, or know someone who might? Vera Sanon's pattern will fit the bill; it offers a good introduction to knitting lace (including how to read a lace chart) and will also give you practice in picking up stitches. It will be a fairly quick knit, but we will knit it over 3 sessions (with more homework between the first 2 sessions than between the last

two) so that no one has to break a sweat.

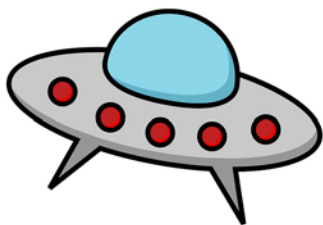
Prerequisites: Cast on, bind off, knit, purl (and be able to distinguish the two)

Materials: Bring the pattern and the materials described therein to the class

Cost: Three 2-hour sessions; \$66

Schedule: Mondays, 7-9 PM, August 1, 8, and 15

UFO Sessions

Have a project you just haven't been able to finish on your own—perhaps you ran into a tricky section of the pattern and just left it to languish in your closet? These UFO (or "un-finished object") sessions are standalone help sessions: attend as

many or as few as you like. You'll learn almost as much from others' knitting problems as from your own, but so that every student will get sufficient attention, each session will be limited to 6 students.

Prerequisites: None!

Materials: Bring your unfinished project and associated pattern and materials

Cost: One 2-hour session; \$20 each

Schedule: Sunday, 10:30-12:30 PM, August 14 (Note date change)

Cabled Cowl

Want to learn how to make cool Aran cables without committing to a sweater? This cowl is a snugly use for cables that you'll have ready in time for the start of the fall. When done, you can felt it lightly, as called for by the pattern, to give it some body or leave it larger and looser for a nice drape.

Prerequisites: Cast on, bind off, knit and purl (and be able to distinguish the two)

Materials: Bring the pattern and all the materials described therein to the first class (requires signing up for a free Lion Brand Yarn account), and arrive ready to

learn to cable, having completed these instructions: Cast on 152 sts and join in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Work in k2, p2 rib for 1 inch.

Cost: Two 2-hour sessions; \$40

Schedule: Mondays, 7-9 PM, August 29 and September 12 (no class Labor Day)
